

Meeker High School

Graduation Requirements

Students must attend 8 semesters of high school and earn a minimum of **240 credits** to graduate. All students must be enrolled in a full-time, seven class Meeker High School schedule.

The following are required:

40 Credits	Language Arts Required: Integrated Reading & Writing I (Freshmen) Integrated Reading & Writing II (Sophomores) or World Literature (Sophomores)* US Literature (Juniors)
40 Credits	Math
30 Credits	Social Studies Required: US History (Juniors) American Government (Seniors)
30 Credits	Science Required: Integrated Physical Science (Freshmen) Integrated Biological Science (Sophomores)
20 Credits	Career Technical Education (Vocational)
10 Credits	Teen Life Skills (Health)
10 Credits	Fine Arts
10 Credits	Physical Education (or participating in 3 sports seasons, excluding managing)
50 Credits	Elective

*Sophomores may test out of Integrated Reading & Writing II and into World Literature by attaining two out of three of the following: 1.) testing Proficient on CSAP in both Reading and Language Arts, 2.) MAP score of 225 on both Reading and Language Usage, 3.) teacher recommendation.
